

The "Sage and Beige"
Winter Wrap, as well as the flower embellishment, can be made of from any combination of yarns and colors that you would like as long as the yarn is medium or worsted weight.

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

13" wide x 60" long/33cm x 152cm

# YOU WILL NEED

300yd/274m of worsted weight yarn (referred to as "yarn a" for body

40yd/37m of worsted weight yarn (referred to as "yarn c", for each flower that you decide to make.

Hook: 5mm/J10 or size needle to obtain gauge

Yarn needle

## STITCHES USED

Chain (ch)
Double Crochet (dc)
Half Double Crochet (hdc)
Slip Stitch (sl st)

### **GAUGE**

7(dc,ch1) repeats = 4''/10cm6 rows = 4''/10cm

## WRAP BODY

With yarn a, ch 213

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across (211 hdc).

Row 2: Ch4 (counts as first dc, ch1 here and throuthout), turn, skip next hdc, dc in next hdc, \*ch1,

skip next hdc, dc in next hdc; repeat from \* across.

Row 3-17: Ch 4, turn, skip next ch-1 space, dc in next dc, \*ch1, skip next ch-1 space, dc in next dc; repeat from \* across.

Row 18: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, hdc in each dc and ch-1 space across.

Fasten off.

#### FLOWER

(Make as many as you intend to use.)

With yarn c, ch 3,; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch3 (counts as first dc here and throughout),
work 7 more dc in ring; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-3 (8dc)

- Rnd 2: Ch5 (counts as dc, ch2) \*dc in next dc, ch2;
  repeat from \* around; join with sl st in 3rd ch of
  beginning ch-5 (8ch-2spaces)
- Rnd 3 (back petals) Sl st into first ch-2 space, (sc, hdc, 3dc, hdc, sc) in each ch 2 space around (8 petals)
- Rnd 4: Working in front of Rnd 3 petals, \*sl st around post of next dc or Rnd 1, ch2; repeat from \* around; join with sl st in first sl st (8ch-2 spaces)
- Rnd 5 (middle petals); Repeat Rnd 3 (8 petals)
- Rnd 6: Working in front of Rnd 5 petals, sl st into
- ring between next 2 sts of Rnd 1, ch2, \* skip next st
- of Rnd 1, sl st into ring between next 2 sts of Rnd 1,
- ch 2; repeat from \* around; join with sl st in first sl
  - st (4 ch-2 spaces).

Rnd 7 (front petals); Repeat Rnd 3 (4 petals, fasten off, leaving a 12"/31cm end for sewing.

#### FINISHING

Sew flowers to pin backs, or to buttons, or directly onto your shawl if desired.

Weave in all yarn ends.
