

SIMPLY BABY SLIPPERS

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These super-simple baby slippers can be worked in any color combination that your heart desires. The slippers can be made in one solid color, or they can be color blocked by changing yarn colors after round 3 or 4. This pattern allows for 4 different sizes, ranging from newborn to 12 months old

YOU WILL NEED: 30-45 yards of worsted weight yarn in the color of your choice. (If you would like to color block the toe cap you will need 10-12 yards of worsted weight yarn in the color of your choice for the toe cap)

Size G/6 crochet needle for shoe sizes 0-3 and 3-6 months

Size H/8 crochet needle for shoe sizes 6-9 and 9-12 months.

STITCHES USED

Chain (ch)

Slip Stitch (sl st)

Single Crochet (sc)

Half Double Crochet (hdc)

Double Crochet (dc)

GAUGE

Using G/6 Sized crochet needle,

15 hdc in 9 rows = 4"x4" square

PATTERN NOTE 1

When making size 0-3 months, or size 3-6 months, use the Size G/6 crochet needle. When making size 6-9 months, or size 9-12 months, use the size H/8 crochet needle.

PATTERN NOTE 2

If you would like to create color blocked slippers, begin the project with the color of yarn that you would like the toe cap to be worked in, then change yarn colors after round 3 or 4, (depending on how large you would like the toe cap color to be).

Slipper Toe

Ch3, join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.



Rnd 1: Ch1 (counts as first hdc, here and throughout), work 6 more hdc in ring; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-1 (7hdc)

Rnd 2: Ch1, hdc in same st as join, work 2 hdc in each st around; join with a sl st in top of beginning ch-1 (14hdc).

Rnds 3-5: Ch1, hdc in each st around; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-1 (14hdc)

{DON'T FORGET TO SWITCH YARN COLORS AFTER RND 3 OR 4, IF YOU WANT TO CREATE A COLOR BLOCKED TOE CAP}

Row 1: Ch1, hdc in next 10 sts (11 hdc).

Rows 2-5: Ch1, hdc in next 10 sts (11 hdc)

(Stop here if you are using a size G/6 crochet needle to make a size 0-3 month shoe, or if you are using a size H/8 crochet needle to make a size 6-9 month shoe)

(If you are making a size 3-6 month shoe, or a size 9-12 month shoe, continue by adding Row 6.)

Row 6: Ch1, turn, hdc in next 10 sts (11 hdc).

Fasten off, leaving a 12 inch tail of yarn. Using yarn needle, and tail, whipstitch the heel closed, and weave in ends. ENJOY!
