# SIMPLY A BIG SCARF

The "Simply A Big Scarf" pattern is a modern, simplistic design, that works quickly and easily. The classic rib sticking resembles knitting. This simple work of hand-hooked architecture is soft, warm and forgivingly stretchy. It is suitable for both lass and las, and can be crocheted in any color that your heart desires.

Simply series is a collection of structurally, very basic designs that were created for four simple purposes.

1. To enable BEGINNERS to create aesthetically & functionally high-end designs that are simplistic in principle, with minimal skill requirements.
2. To enable KNITTERS to cross over & easily access crochet in a clear, uncluttered, and uncomplicated format.
3. To take Advanced and intermediate crocheters into a highly prolific space, by providing an arsenal of well designed, easy, go-to patterns.
4. To create a landscape where all 3 groups can learn foundational structures - where the process has been pared down, enabling you to easily create your own designs & patterns based on these simplistic foundation and techniques.

## STITCHES USED

Chain (ch)  
Single crochet (sc)

## YOU WILL NEED

550yd/504m of worsted weight yarn in the color of your choice

Hook: 4.5mm/G-7 or size needed to obtain gauge

Yarn needle

## GAUGE:

13 sc=4"/10cm

## PATTERN NOTES:

To create the rib stitch effect, the scarf is worked using single crochet stitches, worked in the back loops only.



## THE SCARF

With the yarn of your choice, ch 175.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across (174c).

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in each sc across.

Rows: 3-24: Repeat Row 2.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
