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SIMPLY A FLOWER PIN

This easily mastered, "go to bloom" works up quickly and easily. In addition to hair clips, and pins, this bloom can be made into brooches, shoe clips, sashes, or whatever, your imagination dreams up!

Simply series is a collection of structurally, very basic designs that were created for four simple purposes.

1. To enable BEGINNERS to create aesthetically & functionally high-end designs that are simplistic in principle, with minimal skill requirements.
2. To enable KNITTERS to cross over & easily access crochet in a clear, uncluttered, and uncomplicated format.
3. To take Advanced and intermediate crocheters into a highly prolific space, by providing an arsenal of well designed, easy, go-to patterns.
4. To create a landscape where all 3 groups can learn foundational structures - where the process has been pared down, enabling you to easily create your own designs & patterns based on these simplistic foundation and techniques.

FINISHED MEASUREMENT

3 1/2 " DIAMETER x 2 1/2" deep
9cm x 6cm

STITCHES USED

Chain (ch)
Double crochet (dc)
Slip stitch (sl st)

YOU WILL NEED

40 yd/37m worsted weight yarn in soft pink
Hook: 5.5mm/I-9 or size needed to obtain gauge
Yarn needle
Hair comb (available at most craft stores)

GAUGE:

Take the time to check your gauge.
First 2 rnds = 3 1/12"/9cm
8dc = 2"/5cm

FLOWER

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), work 24 more dc in ring; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-3 (25 dc).

Rnd 2: Ch 3, 7 dc in same dc as join, work 8 dc in each dc around; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-3 (200 dc). Fasten off, leaving a 12"/31cm end for sewing.

FINISHING

Thread 24"/61cm end onto yarn needle and whipstitch back of flower to hair comb. Weave in all yarn ends. Fasten off, leaving a 12"/31cm end for sewing.
