# winter blush

The Winter Blush Neckwarmer is a feminine, flirty, fluffy arrangement of worsted weight lacework.

This simple hand crocheted project, works up quickly and easily. It can be worked in any shade of yarn that your heart desires.



## YOU WILL NEED

175yd/160m of fine weight yarn  
in pink blush

Hook: 5mm/I-9

Yarn needle

## STITCHES USED

Chain (ch)

Half double crochet (hdc)

Double crochet (dc)

Slip stitch (sl st)

## PATTERN NOTES

Double crochet stitches are worked in the spaces between stitches, not in the tops of stitches. The last space is between the last stitch and the beginning chain of the previous row.

## SCARF

Ch 15.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across (13hdc).

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), turn, \*skip next space between sts, 2 dc in next space between sts; repeat from \* across to last space, skip last space, dc in top of beginning ch-2.

Rows 3-29: Ch 3, turn, \*skip next space between sts, 2 dc in next space between sts; repeat from \* across to last space, skip last space, dc in top of beginning ch-3.

Row 30: Ch 2, turn, hdc in each dc across (14hdc).  
Do not fasten off

## RUFFLE (WORK TWICE)

Row 1: Ch 3, turn, 2dc in first hdc, 3 dc in each hdc across (42dc).

Row 2: Ch 3, turn, dc in first dc, 2 dc in each dc across (84dc).

Row 3: Ch 3, turn, dc in first dc, 2 dc in each dc across (168dc). Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in all yarn ends.
