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*This simple, custom sized bowtie pattern is easy to follow.
All that you will need to make this project, is small amounts of left over worsted weight yarn from your stash, 2 buttons, a yarn needle, and a size G6/4mm crochet hook.*

Measure the tie-wearer's neck, and crochet a chain, that is 2 inches longer than the measurement.

1 (the neckband)



Hdc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across.



2

3 (the bow)



Ch 26.

Row 1: Hdc in 2nd ch from hook, and in each ch across; turn.

Rows 2-5: Ch1. Hdc in each st across.



Fold over the edges, 3/4 of an inch, and whip stitch. Repeat on the other edge, and weave in the ends.

(the centerpiece)

Ch, 10. Turn, hdc in 2nd ch, and in each ch across.

Use your fingers to squeeze the center of the bow piece.

Place centerpiece, over the middle of the bow.

Turn the bow over and sew the edges of the centerpiece together (over the middle of the bow).

Slide the neckband, underneath the centerpiece, behind the bow.

Sew one button to the outside of the neckband.

Sew one button to the inside of the neckband.

Use the 2 buttons to fasten the neckband.

By using 2 buttons, the neckband is now, adjustable!

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
