



This project can be worked to any desired length. The look can also be varied by making the ruffle in the same color as the scarf body.

#### **FINISHED SIZE:**

9 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> " wide x 33 " long (24cm x 84 cm)

### **MATERIALS:**

Medium Weight Yarn [7 ounces, 364 yards (198grams, 333meters) per skein]; Onyx – 2 skeins

Medium Weight Yarn [6 ounces, 312 yards (170 grams, 285 meters) per skein]: Iron – 1 skein

Crochet hook, size J (6mm) or size needed for gauge.

NOTE: Work in sps between sts throughout.

### GAUGE:

In pattern, 11 hdc and 10 rows = 4" (10cm)

Gauge Swatch 4" (10cm) square Ch 12

Work same as scarf for 10 rows

# SCARF BODY:

## With Onyx ch 27.

Row 1: hdc in third ch from hook (2 skipped chs count as first hdc) and in each ch across: 26 hdc.

Row 2: (Right side): Ch1 (counts as first st, now and throughout), turn; hdc in first sp and in each sp across.

Note: Loop a short piece of yarn around any stitch to mark Row 2 as right side.

Row 3: ch1, turn; hdc in first sp and in each sp across.

Repeat Row 3 for pattern until scarf measures approximately 27" 68.5cm) from beginning ch, ending by working a right side row.

Finish off.

## FIRST RUFFLE:

Row 1: With wrong side facing, join Iron yarn with slip st in first sp on last row; ch2 (counts as first dc, now and throughout), dc in same sp, 2dc in next sp and in each sp across: 50dc.

Row 2: Ch 2, turn; dc in first sp, 2 dc in next sp and in each sp across; 98dc.

Row 3: Ch2, turn; 2 dc in first sp and in each sp across; 195 dc.

Row 4: Ch 2, turn; 2 dc in first sp, 3 dc in next sp and in each sp across; finish off.

### SECOND RUFFLE:

Row 1: With wrong side facing and working in sps across beginning ch, join Iron yarn with slip st in first sp; ch2, dc in same sp, 2dc in next sp and in each sp across: 50dc.

Row 2: Ch 2, turn; dc in first sp, 2 dc in next sp and in each sp across; 98dc.

Row 3: Ch2, turn; 2 dc in first sp and in each sp across; 195 dc.

Row 4: Ch 2, turn; 2 dc in first sp, 3 dc in next sp and in each sp across; finish off.

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
