This easily mastered, "go to bloom" works up quickly and easily. In addition to hair clips, and pins, this bloom can be made into brooches, shoe clips, sashes, or whatever, your imagination dreams up!

FINISHED MEASUREMENT

3 1/2 " diameter x 2 1/2" deep 9cm x 6cm


YOU WILL NEED

40 yd/37m worsted weight yarn in soft pink

Hook: 5.5mm/I-9 or size needed to obtain gauge

Yarn needle

Hair comb (available at most craft stores)



STITCHES USED

GAUGE

Chain (ch)

Take the time to check your gauge.

Double crochet (dc)

First 2 rnds = $3 \frac{1}{2}$ "/9cm

Slip stitch (sl st)

8dc = 2''/5cm

FLOWER

Ch 4; join wi sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), work 24 more dc in ring; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-3 (25 dc).

Rnd 2: Ch 3, 7 dc in same dc as join, work 8 dc in each dc around; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-3 (200 dc). Fasten off, leaving a 12"/31cm end for sewing.

FINISHING

Thread 24'/61cm end onto yarn needlke and whipstitch back of flower to hair comb. Weave in all yarn ends.

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
