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The Take Flight Winter Cap Pattern is a simple design, that works up quickly and easily.

This warm winter wardrobe staple can be worked in any color combination that your heart desires.

So! Go grab your hot cocoa, your yarn and your hook, and settle in to this quick and rewarding project!

## SIZE

This hat is designed to fit most adult heads.

## YOU WILL NEED

180yd/165m of worsted weight yarn in brown

50yd/45m of worsted weight yarn in orange

Hook: 4.5mm/G-7 or size needed to obtain gauge

Yarn needle

## STITCHES USED

Chain (ch)  
Half double crochet (hdc)  
Single crochet (sc)  
Slip Stitch (sl st)

## GAUGE

Please take the time to check your gauge!

First 5 rnds = 4"/10cm diameter

12 hdc=4"/10cm

## PATTERN NOTES

Half double crochet stitches are worked in the spaces between stitches, not in the top of stitches. The first space is between the beginning chain of the previous round and the next half double crochet.

## HAT

With brown yarn, ch 2; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc here and throughout), work 5 hdc in ring; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-2 (6 hdc).

Rnd 2: Ch 2, hdc in first space between sts, \*2 hdc in next space between sts; repeat from \* around; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-2 (12 hdc).

Rnd 3: Ch 2, hdc in first 2 spaces between sts, 2 hdc in next space between sts, \*hdc in next space between sts, 2 hdc in next space between sts; repeat from \* around to last space, skip last space; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-2 (17 hdc).

Rnd 4: Ch 2, hdc in first 3 spaces between sts, 2 hdc in next space between sts, \*hdc in next 2 spaces between sts, 2 hdc in next space between sts; repeat from \* around to last space, skip last space; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-2 (22hdc).

Rnd 5: Ch 2, hdc in first 4 spaces between sts, 2 hdc in next space between sts, \*hdc in next 3 spaces between sts, 2 hdc in next space between sts; repeat from \* around to last space, skip last space; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-2 (27 hdc).

Rnd 6: Ch 2, hdc in first 5 spaces between sts, 2 hdc in next space between sts, \*hdc in next 4 spaces between sts, 2 hdc in next space between sts; repeat from \* around to last space, skip last space; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-2 (32 hdc).

## SECOND EAR FLAP

Rnd 7: Ch 2, hdc in first 6 spaces between sts, 2 hdc in next space between sts, \*hdc in next 5 spaces between sts, 2 hdc in next space between sts; repeat from \* around to last space, skip last space; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-2 (37 hdc).

Rnds 8-12: Continue as established, working one more hdc between increase in each round (62 hdc).

Rnds 13-23: Ch 2 hdc in each space around; join with sl st in top of beginning ch-2.

Fasten off.

With wrong side of the hat facing you, skip the first 8 spaces following the join, join A with sl st in next space.

Row 1: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc here and throughout) hdc in next 9 spaces between sts (10 hdc).

Rows 2 - 9; Ch 2, turn, hdc in each space across.

Fasten off.

## FIRST EAR FLAP

With right side of the hat facing you, skip the first 8 spaces following the join, join A with sl st in next space.

Row 1: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc here and throughout), hdc in next 9 spaces between sts (10hdc).

Rows 2-9: Ch 2, turn, hdc in each space across.

Fasten off.

## BORDER

With wrong side of the hat facing you, join orange yarn with sl st in back center space.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work sc in each space around entire hat, working 2 sc in corners of earflaps; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off

## FINISHING

Weave in all yarn ends and enjoy!!!
