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SIMPLY A SHOULDER WARMER

Simply series is a collection of structurally, very basic designs that were created for four simple purposes.

1. To enable BEGINNERS to create aesthetically & functionally high-end designs that are simplistic in principle, with minimal skill requirements.
2. To enable KNITTERS to cross over & easily access crochet in a clear, uncluttered, and uncomplicated format.
3. To take Advanced and intermediate crocheters into a highly prolific space, by providing an arsenal of well designed, easy, go-to patterns.
4. To create a landscape where all 3 groups can learn foundational structures - where the process has been pared down, enabling you to easily create your own designs & patterns based on these simplistic foundation and techniques.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

6" long x 21" upper circumference x 41" lower circumference / 15cm x 53cm x 104cm

YOU WILL NEED

95 yds/87m of bulky weight yarn in the color of your choice.

Hook: 6.5 mm /K-10.5 or size needed to obtain gauge
Yarn needle

STITCHES USED

Chain (ch)
Double crochet (dc)
Single crochet (sc)
Slip stitch (sl st)
V-stitch (V-st): (dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated ch-space.

GAUGE

Take time to check your gauge.
6 (dc, ch 1) repeats = 4" /10cm
6 rows = 4" /10cm

COLLAR

With A, ch 54; taking care to not twist the chain, join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 4 (counts as first dc, ch 1), (skip next ch, dc in next ch, ch 1) 2 times, skip next ch, *(dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch (V-st made), ch 1, skip next ch, (dc in next ch, ch 1, skip next ch) 5 times; repeat from * around; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-4 (31 ch-1 space).

Rnd 2: Ch 4 (counts as first dc, ch 1), dc in first ch-1 space (beginning V-st made), ch 1, (dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) 4 times, *V-st in next ch-1 space, ch 1, (dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) 4 times; repeat from * around to last ch-1 space, dc in last ch-1 space, ch 1; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-4 (37 ch-1 space).

Rnd 3: Ch 4 (counts as first dc, ch 1), dc in first ch-1 space (beginning V-st made), ch 1, (dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) across to next V-st, *V-st in ch-1 space of V-st, ch 1, (dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) across to next V-st; repeat from * around; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-4 (43 ch-1 space).

Rnds 4-6: Repeat Rnd 3 (61 ch-1 space).

Rnd 7: Ch 4 (counts as first dc, ch 1), *dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1; repeat from *around; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-4. Fasten off.

Re-join B with sc in any ch-1 space.

Rnd 8: Ch 8, *sc in next ch-1 space, ch 8; repeat from * around; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in all yarn ends.
