Simply A Cowl, is a soft, warm, cozy, and versatile infinity scarf. This unisex cold weather accessory can be worked in any color, or type of worsted weight yarn, making it an awesome no-fuss, stash buster. This cowl can be worn in many ways, so let your crafty imagination run wild!!

Simply series is a collection of structurally, very basic designs that were created for four simple purposes.

1. To enable BEGINNERS to create aesthetically & functionally high-end designs that are simplistic in principle, with minimal skill requirements.
2. To enable KNITTERS to cross over & easily access crochet in a clear, uncluttered, and uncomplicated format.
3. To take Advanced and intermediate crocheters into a highly prolific space, by providing an arsenal of well designed, easy, go-to patterns.
4. To create a landscape where all 3 groups can learn foundational structures - where the process has been pared down, enabling you to easily create your own designs & patterns based on these simplistic foundation and techniques.

STITCHES USED

Chain (ch)
Half double crochet (hdc)

YOU WILL NEED

550yd/504m of worsted weight yarn in the color of your choice
Hook: 4.5mm/G-7 or size needed to obtain gauge
Yarn needle

GAUGE:

13 sc = 4"/10cm
12 rows = 4"/10cm

PATTERN NOTES

To create the rib stitch effect, the scarf is worked using half double crochet stitches, worked in the back loops only.

THE SCARF

With the yarn of your choice, hdc 42.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across (40 hdc).

Row 2: Ch 2, turn, working in back loops only, hdc in each hdc across.

Rows 3-130: Repeat Row 2.

Fasten off.



Carefully line up the edges as pictured, and use your yarn needle to whip stitch the edges together. Fasten off, and weave in your ends.
