## Crochet Frock:

## Material:

Crochet Hook size 3 mm


Crochet Dk Yarn
Yarn Color: Maroon, fawn/Skin, Cyan/sky blue, brown/chocolate color, Sage Green/ light green

## Abbreviation:

Ch - Chain
R - Round / Row
Sc - Single Crochet
dc - Double Crochet
SI St - Slip Stich
Inc - Increase (1dc, ch1, 1dc, 1ch) in single space

## Tips:

- Double Crochet always from single both loop
- don't stitch to-loose or to-tight. Make relax normal hand at the time of crocheting.


## Procedure:

$1{ }^{\text {st }}$ Maroon Color:
Make a Magic Ring
Round 1 (ch3 + 2 dc ), ch 1, $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,3 \mathrm{dc}$, pull the yarn and close with slip stitch.
2nd Fawn Color:
Make a knot and insert in

## $1^{\text {st }}$ Side:

Make a knot and insert.
Chain 1,12 sc ( 1,1 sc in each ) $\quad 1^{\text {st }}$ Granny Square
ch 15 ,
join another square with $12 \mathrm{sc} \quad 2^{\text {nd }}$ Granny Square
increase 15 chain ,
slip stitch where we start the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$.

## Round 2:

_ch 1, make single crochet all around $(12+15+12+15)=54 \mathrm{sc}$
Optional: you can increase number of Rounds with the same pattern sc all around
Same method for the $2^{\text {nd }}$ side

## $2^{\text {nd }}$ Side:

## Round 1:

Make a knot and insert.
Chain $1,12 \mathrm{sc}\left(1,1 \mathrm{sc}\right.$ in each ) $\quad 1^{\text {st }}$ Granny Square
ch 15 ,
join another square with 12 sc $\quad 2^{\text {nd }}$ Granny Square increase 15 chain, slip stitch where we start the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$.

## Round 2:

_ch 1, make single crochet all around $(12+15+12+15)=54 \mathrm{sc}$
Optional: you can increase number of Rounds with the same pattern sc all around

## Frock lower part:

Now we have total 54 crochet stitches.
Make a knot, insert with chain 1,
Round1: $\quad$ Make $54 \mathrm{ch}, 54 \mathrm{dc}$ with this sequence ( $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, \ldots .$. )
Round 2: $54 \mathrm{dc}, 54 \mathrm{ch}$ same sequence ( $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, \ldots .$.

## Shoulder: (optional)

We can increase the shoulder width as per our wish. make a knot.

Row 1: insert and make ch1, sc $12+15+12=39$ sc
Row 2: turn: ch1, 39 sc again
you can add more row with the same pattern to increase the width of the shoulder.
Repeat same pattern on the other side/ shoulder
